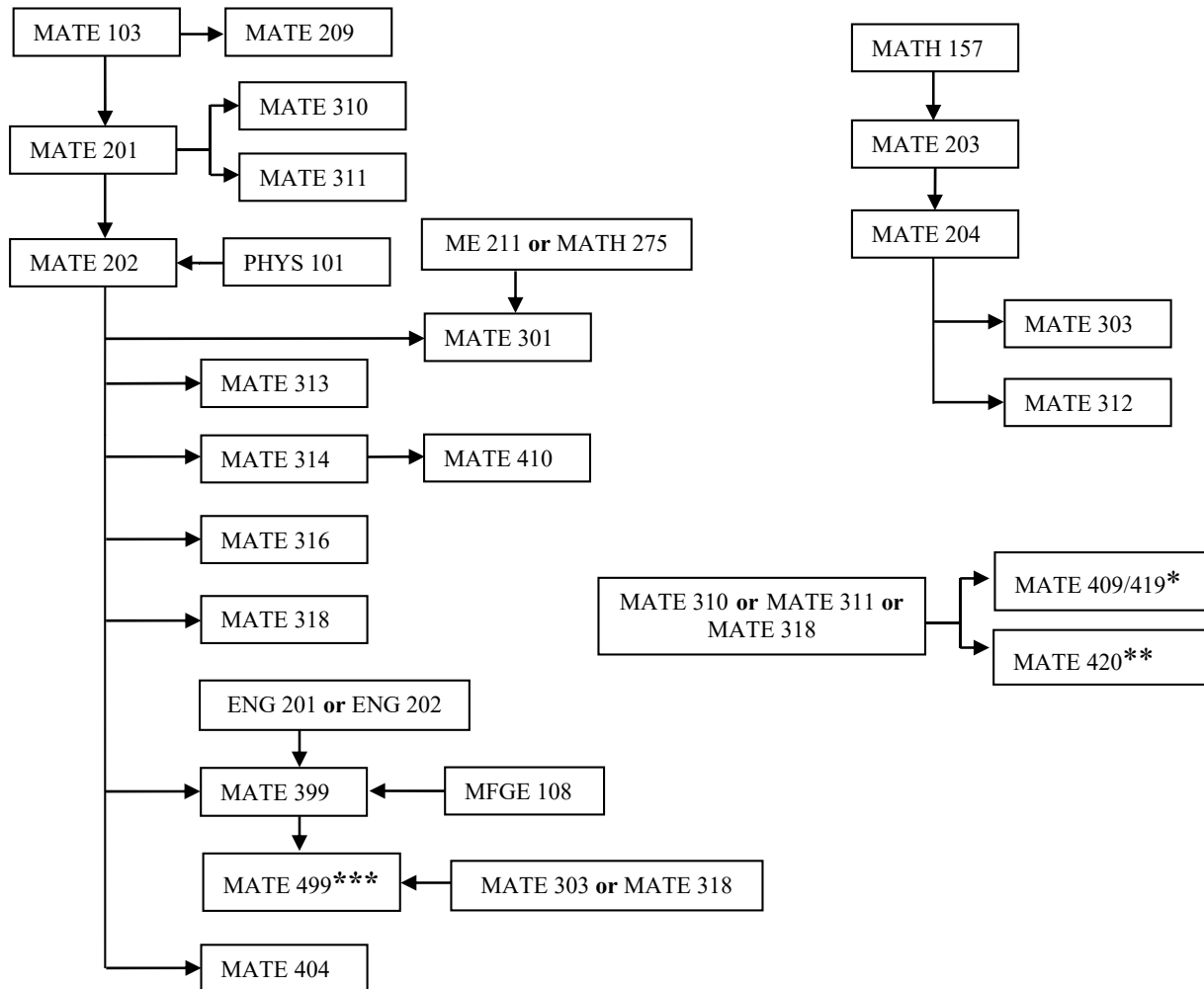


Metallurgical & Materials Engineering Department

Additional Requirements:

* For **MATE 409/419**, in addition to those prerequisites already shown in the chart above, the student should qualify for graduation within maximum three semesters including the semester this course is taken.

** For **MATE 420**, in addition to those prerequisites already shown in the chart above, the student should also qualify for graduation within maximum two semesters including the semester this course is taken.

*** For **MATE 499 Summer Practice II**: in addition to those prerequisites already shown in the chart above, the student must have taken the following 6 courses (MATE 310, MATE 311, MATE 312, MATE 313, MATE 314, MATE 316) and must have passed at least 4 of these.
