 - a- an advertisement for TV or the Internet through shooting a short film in which **ONLY** your team members can perform,
 - b- an advertisement for newspaper or billborad (ellectronically or by hand),
 - c- a poster,
 - d- a wall newspaper,
 - e- a brochure,
 - f- a business card, or
 - g- a logo

Be aware that the creative work that you are going to prepare should be ORIGINAL. Do not forget that all projects should be related to the book and the concepts mentioned in it in a way.

- 5- After the preparation period, you are going to present your project in class. The students who have chosen to work in group should ALL participate during presentation. The mark taken will be shared in group.

As this project aims at enhancing the sense of belonging between Atılım members and bringing them together to share a common topic, Department of Foreign Languages has decided to add this project to the portfolio studies of the students at Eng 211.

Aim: The main aim of this portfolio study that the students at Eng 211 are going to write is to provide each and every student with a chance to explain the quotation given from the book by referring to the extract. Secondly, this portfolio item aims at encouraging students to write their personal comments on the part that they have read.

Guidelines:

- 1- You are expected to read the book.
- 2- You can find a copy of the book at Atılım University Library.
- 3- You should choose **ONE** of the quotations provided below.

"If you say you never had a chance, perhaps you never took a chance" (38)

"As you grow, you need to grow your people, too" (287)

"To stay one step ahead, you have to invest in creativity" (313)

- 4- You should check the part of the book that the quotation is taken from (page numbers on which the quotations are mentioned is provided in parantheses), and you should try to explain how the quotation is related to the extract.
- 5- You should add your personal comments after the explanation.
- 6- You do not need to put this portfolio item in a specific organization format.
- 7- You should write and submit this portfolio item on the date that is determined by your instructor.

 - b- You can search for some news associated with the general topic "Starbucks" and you can synthesize the news you find with your comments on it.
 - c- You can survey the opinions of people around you about the topic and/or the book and develop your survey into a newspaper article.

Be aware that the creative work that you are going to prepare should be ORIGINAL. Do not forget that all projects should be related to the book and the concepts mentioned in it in a way.

- 4- Before you start writing your article, inform your instructor about your plan.
- 5- While writing your article, you should follow the format expected by your instructor. (e.g. word limit, font, size, visuals, etc.).
- 6- After the preparation period, you are going to present your project in class. **ALL** group members **should** participate during presentation. The mark taken will be shared in group.
- 7- The duration of presentation for each project will be 4-5 minutes.
- 8- If you are absent in class on the day you are supposed to present your speech, you will not be given a make-up, unless you have a medical report.
