**According to the regulations “Undergraduate students whose semester and cumulative grade point averages are equal to or higher than 2.00 are deemed to have passed.” Moreover, “Undergraduate and associate degree students whose grade point average and semester point average is lower than 2.00 are accepted to be unsatisfactory. Students (Added statement: RG-13/3/2020-31067) in programs other than Medicine who are registered in the second or higher semester at the University and whose GPA is lower than 1.70 at the end of registered semester may repeat failed courses and take a maximum of 15 new credits in order to increase their GPA over 1.70. Students whose GPA is equal to and higher than 1.70 and less than 2.00 may take courses as much as their course load including new courses; however, failed courses must be taken primarily.”**
