

## UNIVERSITY THESIS WRITING GUIDLINE COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST and THESIS/ PROJECT DELIVERY FORM

Items		Advisor Approval	Grad. School Approval	
1.	All theses must be bound in burgundy synthetic, faux leather, or similar fabric.			
2.	The binding margin (left margin) must be exactly 4 cm, and the other margins must be exactly 2.5 cm.			
3.	The formatting of the inner covers must match the items on Pages 8, 9, 10, and 11 of the Thesis Writing Guidelines, and the "Thesis Template".			
4.	The font size must be 12. The only acceptable font is the Times New Roman.			
5.	The title, in capital letters, must be centered within the text area, and 3.5 cm below the page margin. The title must be placed two lines below, centered, and in capital letters. The text must begin two lines below.			
6.	The line spacing must be set to 1.5. Single line spacing may be used for tables, long quotations, footnotes, endnotes, bibliography, and headings.			
7.	All page numbers in theses must be centered at the bottom of the page.			
8.	Small Roman numerals (i, ii, iii, iv, etc.) must be used to number the first pages. The actual page numbers must begin on the Abstract page numbered "iii".			
9.	The first page of the thesis text must begin with the number "1", and continue accordingly.			
10.	On the initial pages, the title must be in all capital letters, single-spaced, and 3.5 cm below the top of the page.			
11.	The thesis approval page must be signed with a blue pen.			
12.	2. Chapters must be capitalized and numbered starting with the number "1" (CHAPTER 1, CHAPTER 2, etc.).			
13.	3. Table numbers and titles must be placed one line above the top line of tables; figure numbers and titles must be placed one line below the bottom line or end point of figures.			
14.	14. All figures, including appendices, must be listed sequentially. Decimal numbers must be used for ordering purposes (1.1, 1.2, 1.3, A.1, A.2; the first digit must correspond to the chapter or appendix number, and the number after the decimal point must indicate the number of the image in the relevant section or appendix).			
15.	5. Mathematical and chemical formulas, equations, and expressions must be prepared using an equation editor. Each equation must be numbered in parentheses, placed next to the right margin.			
	6. Quotations within the thesis text must be numbered. Ex.: Smith [3], or [3]. Citations must be listed in alphabetical order.			
17.	7. The formatting of the bibliography must match the items on Pages 16, 17, and 18 of the Thesis Writing Guidelines.			
18.	18. If multiple appendices are required for the information to be enclosed, each appendix must be assigned a separate letter (Appendix A, Appendix B, etc.).
